The project is currently scoping proof of concept prototypes to respond to specific use cases, and these will be used to assess the feasibility of, and priorities for, developing a service. Our second areas of focus will be on the challenges of monitoring total spend for Open Access and Standards Development to enable efficient data exchange. The purpose of the second workshop is again to inform the project's work by going further in capturing institutional requirements, identifying common ground and exploring variances in practice.
